Works notification: Fogarty Avenue drainage works and traffic changes

From 16 November to late December, there will be traffic changes along Fogarty Avenue and The Avenue as we continue works to replace drainage pipes, install cladding on the new walking and cycling overpass and widen the West Gate Freeway.

Fogarty Avenue drainage works

23 November 2020 until late December 2020

Work will soon be underway on Fogarty Avenue to replace council drainage pipes. The works will be undertaken along Fogarty Avenue, between the Footscray Hockey Club and Wembley Avenue.

Barriers will be in place to separate the work area and the road. Drivers will still be able to travel through Fogarty Avenue, and will need to give way to oncoming cars when passing the work area.

- footpath access will be maintained
- property access will be maintained
- waste collection will also be maintained
- parking along Fogarty Avenue will be temporarily unavailable during this time – please see the map over page for location details
- we recommend that you park your vehicle along the remaining sections of Fogarty Avenue

Traffic changes on Fogarty Avenue and The Avenue

16 November to early December

Fogarty Avenue, between Wembley Avenue and Tenterden Street

Earlier this year we temporarily closed Fogarty Avenue between Wembley Avenue and Tenterden Street until late October 2020. This was so we could safely construct the ramp for the new walking and cycling overpass.

We will be reinstating this road closure from 16 November to early December 2020 so we can complete cladding on the ramp. Traffic management will continue to be on-site to maintain access for residents. See map for location details.

The Avenue, at Newport Rail Bridge

Last month we told you that we will be temporarily closing The Avenue at Newport Rail Bridge to install new barriers and pour concrete. These works have been rescheduled to start from 16 November 2020 and will go for approximately three weeks.

The footpath underneath the bridge will remain open allowing pedestrians and cyclists to safely detour around the works.

The community shuttle bus will also detour via Williamstown Road and the bus stop outside the Footscray Hockey Club will be closed for three weeks while works take place.

What you could expect:

- an increase in the number of construction vehicles in the area
- an increase in construction noise from our machinery and trucks
- water spray trucks to help manage dust and dirt and covered loads when dirt and rock when are being transported
- traffic changes will be required including road and lane closures.

We thank you for your patience while we complete these works.

These works will generally be carried out from Monday to Friday between 7am - 6pm and Saturdays between 7am - 1pm, however some night works may be required. When works are scheduled out of hours and may have a direct impact on you, we will provide further information to you before works start.
